Closer to a Cure

Zander Therapeutics, Inc. reported that researchers for Regen BioPharma Inc. have identified what the company believes to be a strong activator for modulating checkpoint NR2F6. Zander is the exclusive licensee of Regen BioPharma's technology for veterinary applications. The NR2F6 nuclear receptor has been identified as a potentially very important immune cell inhibitor and cancer stem cell differentiator. The NR2F6 program at Regen aims to identify antagonists of NR2F6 in an effort to unleash



the cancer-killing potential of a patient's own immune system.

Researchers identify a common underlying genetic basis for social behavior in dogs and humans

An interdisciplinary team of researchers, including those from Princeton University, sequenced a region of chromosome 6 in dogs and found multiple sections of canine DNA that were associated with differences in social behavior. In many cases, unique genetic insertions called transposons on the Williams-Beuren syndrome critical region (WBSCR) were strongly associated with the tendency to seek out humans for physical contact, assistance and information.
